Programs

Adult Day Services are conducted in a friendly, supportive and positive atmosphere design to provide successful experiences for the participants in all areas of their lives. Caring, experienced staff provide services and training that promote health, safety, and increased opportunities for access, choice and inclusion in the community.

Participants

Adult Day Service is open to adults with development disabilities who require assistance and supervision but wish to maintain their independence. This includes:

- Adults who benefit from person centered and structured programming
- Adults with developmental disabilities
- Adults that require supervision or assistance with activities of daily living
- Adults who require therapeutic structure, supervision and intervention due to cognitive impairments
- Adult whose family and/or caregivers need respite care

Admission is based on formal assessment of a potential participant's needs and interests.

Benefits

Participants in Easter Seals Adult Day Services benefit from:

- Personalized care based on individual needs
- Increased involvement in their local community
- Opportunities to value relationships in the community
- Increased opportunities in community outreach work

Caregivers benefit from knowing their loved one is receiving the best possible care in a safe, home-like environment while they are working, running errands or taking a well-deserved break.

Services

A variety of services are available for participants and caregivers including:

- Assistance with personal cares
- Medication administration
- Activities that are meaningful and purposeful
- Involvement in the community through outreach
- Computer access
- Health and wellness promotion

Meals

Participants bring their own lunches and with staff's assistance help prepare their own lunches.

Cost
