Kenosha Y Closed Beginning Monday, 3/16

Due to the recent update regarding the state of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Wisconsin and the response from Wisconsin Department of Health to order all public schools to close in an effort to minimize the spread of the virus, the Y will be joining the many other community facilities and schools that will be closing in a community-wide effort to slow the spread of this virus and maintain public health. The Kenosha YMCA will be closed to the public for two weeks beginning Monday, March 16 through Sunday, March 29.

This is not a decision that was taken lightly. The YMCA is a place where community comes together. Today we need to come together in a different way and practice social distancing to do our part in slowing the spread of novel coronavirus (COVID-19). There have been no known cases in connection with our facility.

This is an unprecedented situation and will be an inconvenience for us all. We are incredibly empathetic to how this closure may affect you. As you know, information regarding this issue is constantly evolving, so unfortunately, we do not have the answers to all the questions that you may have. But, we want to reiterate our commitment to our members, employees, volunteers, and community at-large. We will work together to address issues that arise due to this closure in an effort to support our members and preserve the future of our organization.

Please see below for a few details regarding our closure.

The Y will be closed beginning Monday, March 16. The anticipated duration of the closure is a minimum of 14 days, however, that can change.

For our members, we will move our annual summer maintenance shutdown to occur during this time and provide 3 additional guest passes to each member.

The current spring 1 session will be extended until May 10, 2020 in order to fulfill 8 weeks of programming.
