EMERGENCY CHILDCARE CENTER FOR ESSENTIAL EMPLOYEES

Although our Kenosha YMCA is currently closed to members due to COVID-19, we are pivoting our services and offering limited childcare to those who serve as first responders, medical professionals, government officials, and those essential employees who continue their work during this challenging time. We do this with the support and recommendation of the State of Wisconsin Department of Children and Family Services, Department of Health Services, the Department of Instruction, and in consideration Governor Evers' order that emphasizes the importance of Child Care Centers being available to essential employees.

In Order 11, Governor Evers' list of essential businesses include grocery stores and food production, pharmacies, health care, utilities, shipping, banking, other governmental services, law enforcement, child care for essential employees, and emergency personnel.

Care will begin being offered Monday, March 30, 2020. (If minimum enrollment numbers are met)

Hours: Monday –Friday 6:00 AM – 8:00 PM (weekends if needed)

Ages: 3 yrs. – 12 yrs. (6th grade)

Rates: \$30 per day (financial assistance available)

Meals provided: Breakfast, Lunch, Snack, Dinner
