JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for the health and safety of children in the program
- Maintain a professional attitude and relationship with parents
- Attend & hold staff meetings
- Complete billing, parent conferences and supervise staff
- This is a full-time position, approximately 30-35 hours per week

- 21 years or older
- 15 Course credit hours in Education or a related field pertaining to working with School Age children (5yrs-12yrs old) including a course in Child or Human Development OR completion of non-credit courses "Introduction to the Child Care Profession" & "Skills & Strategies of Child Care Teacher". Completed Administrator's & Leadership course.
- 2 years' experience teaching children
- Ability to provide proof of First Aid and CPR Certification
- Provide Wisconsin Registry at a Level 12 or higher rating. Registry Certificate indicates approved to work as a Site/Center Director.
- Basic math and writing skills; excellent verbal communication skills
- Ability to work cooperatively with youth, parents, staff and community organizations
- Joy and satisfaction in working with children
- Ability to work independently
- Maintain a valid driver's license
